





















Census Mapping Module: Fingal














Data from schools 2019:

- 50 59.3% travel by foot
- 3.7 15% travel by bike, scooter, skateboard, flicker
- 14.8 35% travel by car (28.8 35% when park and stride is included)







When surveyed:

- 44.4% of students said their preference would be to cycle
- 40% said having a friend to travel with would be their main motivation to make the change
