

Brazilian society advocating for the inclusion of bicycles in urban mobility plans





PROBLEM

- •According to the National Urban Mobility Policy (Federal Law 12.587/2012), by April 2015, all municipalities with more than 20.000 inhabitants in Brazil should have presented an Urban Mobility Plan
- •However, more than 70% of the cities haven't done it yet and cycling should be a priority
- •Many of these cities have very engaged cyclists organised in groups/NGOs, but not all have experience and knowledge to advocate in urban planning processes

SOLUTION

•A national campaign to unite these engaged cyclists and citizens to advocate on cycling in their cities' Urban Mobility Plan - BICICLETA NOS PLANOS ("BICYCLE IN THE PLANS")

GOALS


- •To encourage and to guide citizens and urban planners from Brazilian cities to engage on the inclusion of the bicycle as a means of transport in the Urban Mobility Plans
- •To collaborate in the promotion of urban democracy, environmental sustainability and quality of life of citizens

TARGET AUDIENCE

- •Cycling organizations and other social movements, technical and policy makers, consultants and other interested parties
- •We aim to engage at least 30 cities: 10 which were selected from small to large in all regions of Brazil and receiving personalized advisory; other cities voluntarily through our website


- Personalized advisory on local advocacy and lobbying

RESULTS

- 10 cities have already prepared their Work Plans to develop the campaign
- In addition, 27 cities are interested in voluntarily participating in the campaign
- More than 400 views of the Online Campaign Launch Workshop
- •1.057 people expressed support for campaign
- More than 10.500 views of the website
- •230 downloads of Reference Guide "Bicycle inclusion in Urban Mobility Plans"
