



Main Features

- ■1 circuit: 80–XXX km
- ■Cycle through varied and beautiful scenery: the shores of Lake Hamana, coastal roads, mountain farming roads and hot spring towns
- There is a dedicated cycle path for 40 km on the eastern shore of the lake

Rental Cycles


 Terminals: 7 locations

 Fee: Adults 500yen per day Children 300yen per day


Deposit: 1,000yen


