








Cycling in Denmark (2011-2014)

- 4 % of person transport
- 16 % of trips
- 21 % of commuter trips
- 38 % of education trips
- 3.3 bn.km. (2014)

The fund

- €138M/CN¥1BN/NT\$5BN
- 338 subsidy- & 50 state projects
- 70 % subsidy & 30 % state
- Types of projects (Subsidy share)
- Cycle Cities (31%)
- Commuter Cycling (26%)
- Cycling to school and leisure (26%)
- Recreational cycling (10%)
- Campaigns and development (8%)

- 161 projects of 338 projects
- 250 km cycle lanes
- 3,250 cycle parking spots



Increase in cycling

- 59 projects with before and after bicycle counts
- 112 km of bikelane/track
- 24 % increase in cycling


- Aarhus (260.000)

Safety feeling




