




8 years ago Gothenburg had congestion problems in the city centre

**Objectives** 

SUSTAINABLE CITY - OPEN TO THE WORLD

- Reduce the number of deliveries with heavy trucks after 11.00 am
- Improve and increase accessibility for urban freight
- Improve local environment (noise, safety, air pollution, attractiveness)







# Regulations and incentives





Time windows (5 am-10 am) on the pedestrian streets

Length regulations, maximum 10 m.

Less one way streets – pedestrian pace areas

Improved accessibility for distribution vehicles

Reduces driven distance and time

### City Delivery Concept: "Stadsleveransen"






- Common goods reception for shops and offices in the city centre
- Handling of small shipments (packages)
- Functions both as a c/o adress and as a subcontracted haulier
  - Consolidation and last mile delivery with electric vehicles and cargo bikes
  - Owned by the trade association
  - Operated by a local company specialized in last mile distribution with electric vehicles
  - Continuously expanded and developed

#### **Consolidation center and last mile**



# Different prerequisites for different businesses....





#### Challenges



- Behaviour change takes time
- The consolidation is considered as extra costs for the last mile; it needs to be clarified, show the benefits for each part
- IT-solution for handeling goods from different transport companies
- Create competetice edge for consolidation services with clean vehicles (in relation to ordinary distribution)
- Complexity with many stakeholders (some of them competetors)

#### Key factors for success



- Patience/persistence

- A balance between access restrictions (sticks) and incentives (carrots)

- Enforcement
- -Infrastructural changes


- Local freight network and dialogue with all stakeholder
